

# Course Outline: Esthetics

A 750 hour program of training requiring approximately 30 weeks or approximately 7.5 months for part-time attendance. Each of the following units of study will be covered in both theory and practical training, **available at Missouri College of Cosmetology South/Esthetics only**. The Esthetics Course will prepare the student for employment as an Esthetician.

#### **Course Goals**

The course of study is designed to prepare the student to successfully pass the Licensing Exam required by the State Board of Cosmetology in the State of Missouri only, and to offer the student basic entry skills for profitable employment in the field of esthetics dealing with total skin care.

### **Course Format**

The Basic Training portion of the course will be primarily all classroom study, in theory and practice of basic skills necessary to train in the clinic floor setting. Students in basic training will not work on clinic floor until completing 75 hours of basic training and passing both practical and theory requirements.

The Advanced Theory and Clinic Training portion of the course consists primarily of the development of all necessary practical skills, supplemented with classroom lectures, demonstrations, tests and review in all subject areas teaching methods.
